

BICYCLE ROUTES

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Boulevards on the Brda green route,
about 5 km, 40 minutes.

By the city parks and downtown blue route,
about 3,5 km, 45 minutes,
to Myslecinek + 1 hour.

To the Old City the red route,
about 2.5 km, 30 minutes.



Boulevards on the Brda

(green route, about 5 km, 40 minutes)

Walking tour along the boulevards on the Brda.
Ideal for a ride on a sunny after noon.

We leave Hotel directing to the left in the direction of roundabout Jagiellonow, after which go straight, then go toward **Brda River**. At the river turn left and then along boulevards we get to **the Pomeranian Bridge**. After getting to the bridge cross the Brda and near Toruńskie Roundabout on the other side of the river, turn right down towards the park (not in the "snail" - exit the shop!). Along the path we get to **"The Archer" Sports and Entertainment Hall** (Luczniczka Hall). Then, staying on the right side of the tram tracks, head towards the center of Bydgoszcz, passing by rowing clubs. Reaching the Bernardyński Bridge comes out of it and turn right towards roundabout Jagiellonów and the Hotel.

By the city parks and downtown

(blue route, about 3,5 km, 45 minutes, to Myslecinek + 1 hour)

Route leads through the park's main attractions downtown Bydgoszcz. You can extend it to drive to the Forest Park of Culture and Recreation in Myslecinek.

After leaving the hotel turn right after 100 meters to the Moczyńskiego street and then go between the blocks to get to **the park Witos**. Park alleys go toward road Markwarta and roundabout Ossolinski. Reach the impressive building of **Basilica Minor**. Further avenues Ossolińskich go to the nearest intersection, turn left where we enter into the Wyspiański street and present get to the picturesque neighborhood of idyll called Sielanka.

Leave it to Reymont street and then head to **Kochanowski Park** and district of music. In this area is a **the Pomeranian Philharmonic** and music schools of all levels. Go through the park towards Mickiewicz Avenue, at which you pass the Polish Theatre building. Avenues you get to the Gdanska Street. At this point we can turn to the right, towards **the Myslecinek**, one of the largest urban park in Poland - about 4 km drive straight along the Gdanska street. If you like to return to the hotel, turn left and follow the Gdanska street until the narrow Parkowa street, then you turn left. We get to **the Kazimierz Wielki Park**, by which you arrive to Jagiellonska street. Then left towards round Jagiellonow, under which we pass, towards the left, towards the hotel.

To the Old City

(the red route, about 2.5 km, 30 minutes)

Short route that allows access to the center of Bydgoszcz Old Town and the Wyspa Młyńska/ Mill Island - a place full of charm, which in recent years undergone an extraordinary transformation.

From the Hotel we head towards Ronda Jagiellonów. Carry a bike under the roundabout and head towards the **Brda River**. Pass under the bridge and continue towards the old city boulevards. Near the **Opera Nova** you cross the bridge over Brda and you enter **the Wyspa Mlynska/ Mill Island**. It is worth pausing to take a look at exposures that are in the majority of the buildings located on the Island. Wyspa Mlynska/ Mill Island you leave by going on Mennica street and head towards **the Old Market Square** - the historic medieval center of Bydgoszcz. After seeing the sights leave the local street market by Mostowa street and get to the characteristic **granaries** - one of the Bydgoszcz symbols. Next to the granaries turn into Grodzka Street. At the end of the street head towards the river and you pass under the Bernardynski bridge. After that please go through the bridge and head right towards Rondo Jagiellonow and then to City Hotel.
